

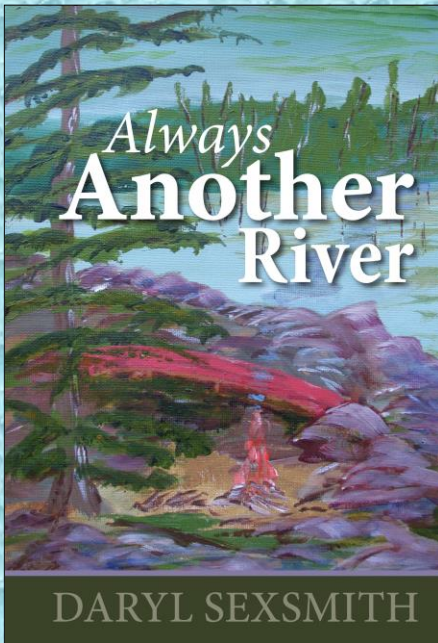
# Daryl Sexsmith Author Reading

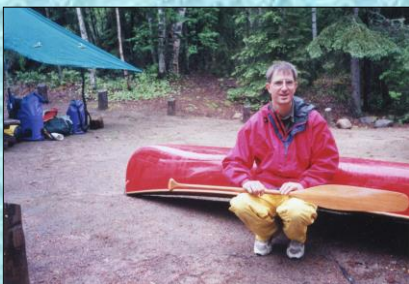
Daryl Sexsmith grew up at Prince Albert and later went on to graduate from the University of Saskatchewan and Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario.
