Connie Freedy was born in 1944 in Cutknife, Saskatchewan. Growing up on a farm, at a young age she develop ed an appreciation of the land, and a knowledge of food sources and preparation. Connie worked as a children's art teacher at the Prince Albert Arts Centre in Prince Albert (now the Margo Fou rnier Arts Centre), as a tour guide in Fort Carlton Provincial Historic Park, and later as the co-owner and chef of Yellow Fender Coffee House & Eatery in Christopher Lake.

Connie's work has been exhibited in group and solo exhibitions in Saskatchewan and Alberta. Her work is represented in the collections of the Mann Art Gallery, SK Arts, Remai Modern (Saskatoon), and Dunlop Art Gallery (Regina).
